


What is the Jobs Guarantee?

It does not need to be that way!


The Jobs Guarantee offers us a chance at the lives we deserve.

It creates improved conditions for union and other movements of workers to advocate for not only the best jobs we can create, but also the best society we can imagine.



Why now?

The climate crisis has showcased that we need to fundamentally transform society. Last year, Representative Ayanna Pressley introduced a resolution of a version of the Federal Jobs Guarantee in Congress.





This resolution is a building block for movements to refine what must be in the Jobs Guarantee.

Now is the time to get involved and turn this proposal into reality.
